CALL FOR ENTRIES TO THE PREMIO LISSONE 2014

The competition, for which entrance is free, is aimed at Italian and international artists under 35, working in the medium of paint.

Entries must be submitted to the event planning office by 5 September 2014.

All the documentation can be downloaded from the website www.museolissone.it.

The Premio Lissone 2014, promoted and organised by the Town of Lissone and its Modern Art Museum, is now open for entries.

The competition, for which entrance is free, is aimed at Italian and international artists under 35 working in the medium of paint.

Major attention will be dedicated not only to the traditional discipline (on canvas or paper) but also to related objects and concepts, on unconventional and three-dimensional supports, particularly within the scope of "expanded painting".

The award, which continues the prestigious tradition began with its 1950s and '60s editions, boasting the participation of some of the world's leading artists, such as Adami, Appel, Birolli, Dorazio, Moreni, Morlotti, Ruggeri, Scanavino, Schifano, Tàpies and Vedova, sets out to promote and enhance contemporary art and its many languages, create opportunities for exchange and visibility for the artists of the future, develop relationships and active synergies on an international level, and increase the museum collection of the Town of Lissone.

All documentation must be submitted by 5 September 2014 to the event planning office, at the address "Comune di Lissone – Ufficio Protocollo, via Gramsci 21, 20851 Lissone (MB), Italia".

The call for entries can be downloaded from the website www.museolissone.it.

The entries will be initially assessed by a **Selection Committee**, which will pick out the finalists, on the basis of the original nature of the entry and consistency in research, as well as the candidate's artistic qualities.

The works by these young artists will then be evaluated by the **Panel of judges**.

The winner will receive a purchase prize of € 5,000 and the winning entry will become part of the permanent collection of the Lissone Modern Art Museum.

The selected artists will exhibit their work in a group exhibition, complete with catalogue, taking place next autumn in the Lissone Modern Art Museum.

As of this year, the Premio Lissone 2014 will feature a direct invitation section, curated by the art director of the Modern Art Museum. The works of the invited artists shall be considered "out of competition" and shall not compete in any way for the assignment of prizes.
